Our international operations are focused on offshore oil developments and have grown significantly over the last several years in the marine environments of Southeast Asia. We are involved with production, active development and ongoing exploration offshore Malaysia and China.

Our international operations are focused on offshore oil developments and have grown significantly over the last several years in the marine environments of Southeast Asia. We are involved with production, active development and exploration offshore Malaysia and China.

Newfield has a long history in the marine environment since it began operations in 1988 with a Gulf of Mexico focus. International marine operations allow Newfield to bring its extensive deep water expertise into play. Our international operations have brought oil growth, recent record level production levels in areas with additional development and exploration upside.

We have several active oil developments offshore Malaysia and China. We have an interest in approximately 925,000 net acres offshore Malaysia and approximately 290,000 net acres offshore China.

As of April 2012, our net production from Malaysia was a record 30,000 BOEPD.

In Malaysia, our PM 329 development, East Piatu, commenced production in the fourth quarter of 2011. We have a 70% operated interest in the development.

Our other facility includes East Belumut, located at PM 323. We also have an oil and gas discovery in deepwater block 2C offshore Malaysia known as “Paus” with drilling here planned for later 2012. We have a 30% interest.

We are developing our “Pearl” discovery (initial production late 2013/early 2014) in the Pearl River Mouth Basin of China with a \$100 million investment in development of this field.
